- **Annual Report**

The First 5 California Research and Evaluation Division mailed a letter under Kris Perry's signature to all Executive Directors indicating missing information from county commission 06-07 annual report submittals.

- **Power of Preschool (PoP)**

We are developing new Web-based forms for PoP evaluation reporting. In addition, we will create new PoP Reporting Guidelines to accompany the new Web-based forms. We will work with PoP counties to test the new Web-based system and PoP Reporting Guidelines.

- **Center for Results**

The Center for Results has hired Eclipse Solutions to write a Request for Proposal (RFP) to secure a vendor to develop an IT solution to support the Center for Results. Stacie Sormano will present an overview of the procurement process at the 2008 First 5 California Pre-Conference Institute. Eclipse Solutions will facilitate county input. Currently there are still two contractors left to hire for the Center for Results; a Strategic Research contractor and a Local Evaluation contractor.
