

TA CONFERENCE CALL NOTES
January 22, 2008

- **Access to individual level data pre February 22, 2007.** Counties can gain access to individual level data they entered into PEDS prior to February 22, 2007 by asking participants to sign a new consent form. First 5 California is currently working with its Institutional Review Board to approve a new consent form in the next few weeks. We will send out a letter to counties explaining the process for getting the deidentified data.
- **Technology Request for Offer** responses were due late December 2007. First 5 sent the RFO out to several contractors and we received no responses. We made changes to the RFO sending it out to over 30 vendors. The responses are due February 11, 2008. We hope to have a contractor on board by the end of February 2008.
- **Special Need Definition** is now available at <http://www.first5eval.com/reportingtools.htm>. The definition combines several definitions and is now one universal First 5 California definition. First 5 California requests counties begin using the new definition immediately.
- **Center for Results** implementation strategy is located at <http://www.first5eval.com/center4results.htm>. We anticipate releasing a scope of work in March 2008 using one of Department of General Services leveraged procurement processes.
- **2006-2007 Annual Report** (AR) Stacie Sormano will present the AR to the First 5 California commission on Thursday, January 24, 2008.
