- **Project Legacy**
Information for the Legacy Project is available on the CCFC Web site at www.cafc.ca.gov. The site includes attachments and diagrams explaining our plans for the Legacy Workgroup. There is also a list of Frequently Asked Questions and an in-box for questions concerning Project Legacy. At it's September 18 meeting, the First 5 California Commission approved the Project Legacy implementation plan and the Workgroup categories.
- **2007-08 Annual Report & School Readiness**
First 5 California staff completed its in-person and on-line training on September 16, providing training to more than 170 staff members and all counties. Thanks to all who participated. - **Health Access**
First 5 California released a new report to Executive Directors and program coordinators which includes 2006 Healthy Kids Program utilization and quality HEDIS data. We are currently working with the University of Southern California on the survey for Healthy Kids Families evaluating the impact of Healthy Kids programs.
- **Power of Preschool (PoP)**
There is a two-part evaluation in process for PoP: a statewide evaluation and data collection effort for annual reporting, and a meta-analysis of the local county PoP evaluations. A contractor will be conducting the meta-analysis, which includes county follow-up to collect information.
- **School Readiness**
First 5 California is in the process of securing a contractor to conduct a meta-analysis of information gathered from county evaluations of School Readiness programs.
- **Special Needs**

The Institute for Social Research is helping First 5 California conduct two surveys: one of families who have participated in the Special Needs program and another of School Readiness sites.

- **PEDS**

First 5 California staff continues to work on county intake and follow-up questions.
