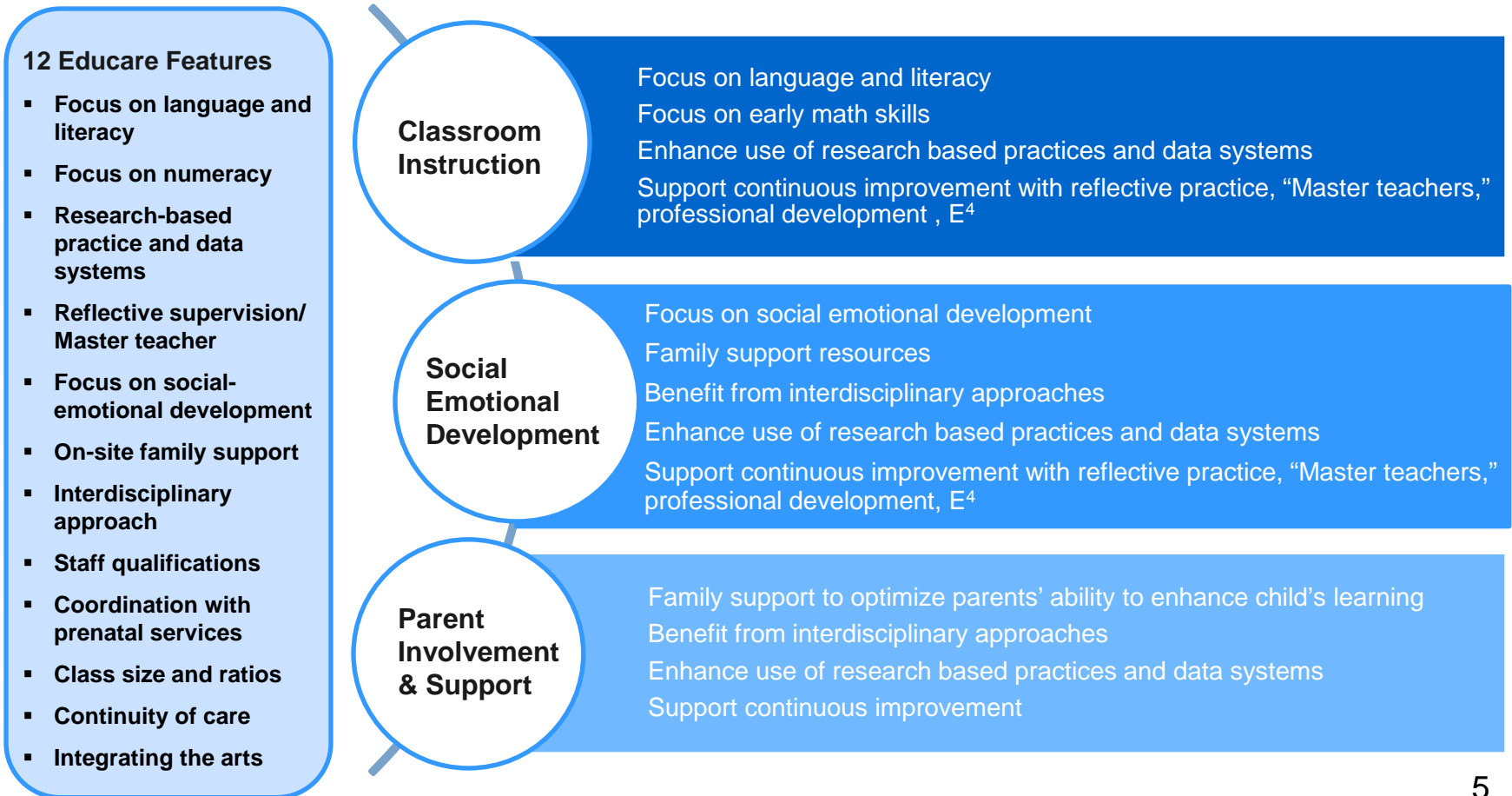
3-year learning oriented expansion of PoP aims to:

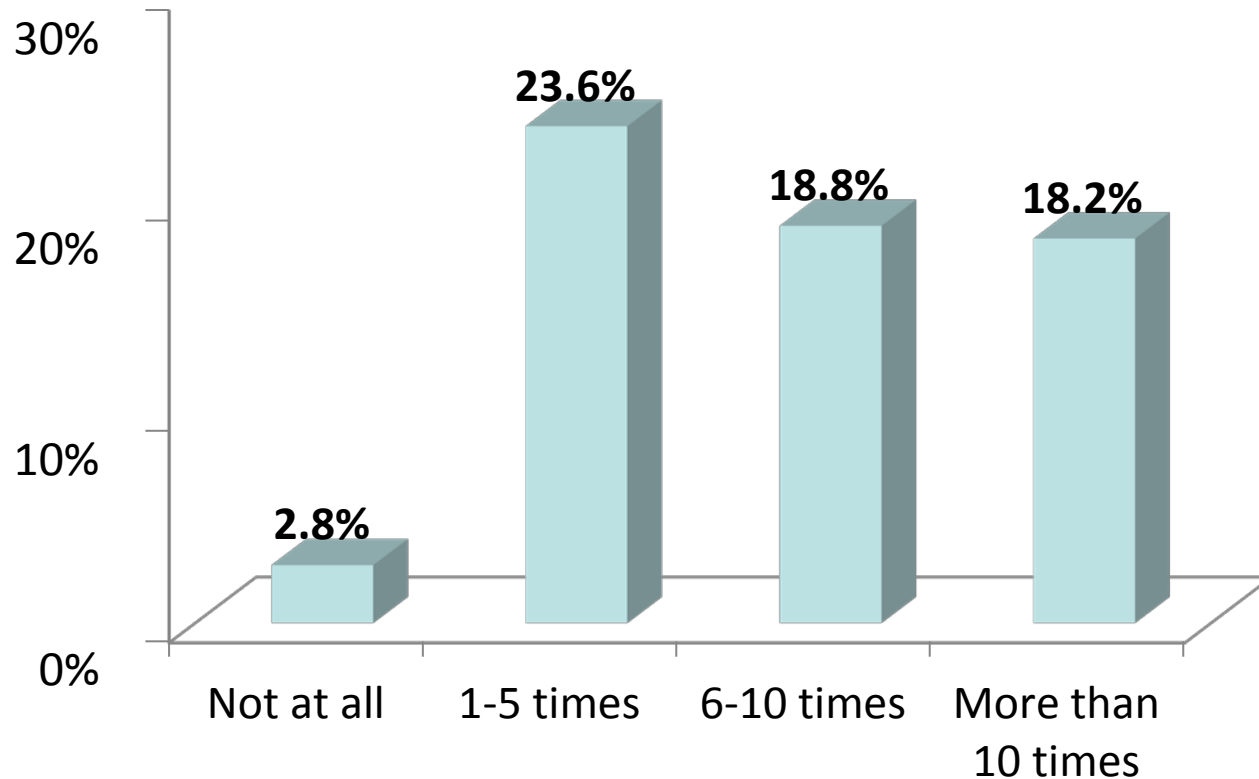

Kit for New Parents Survey Results

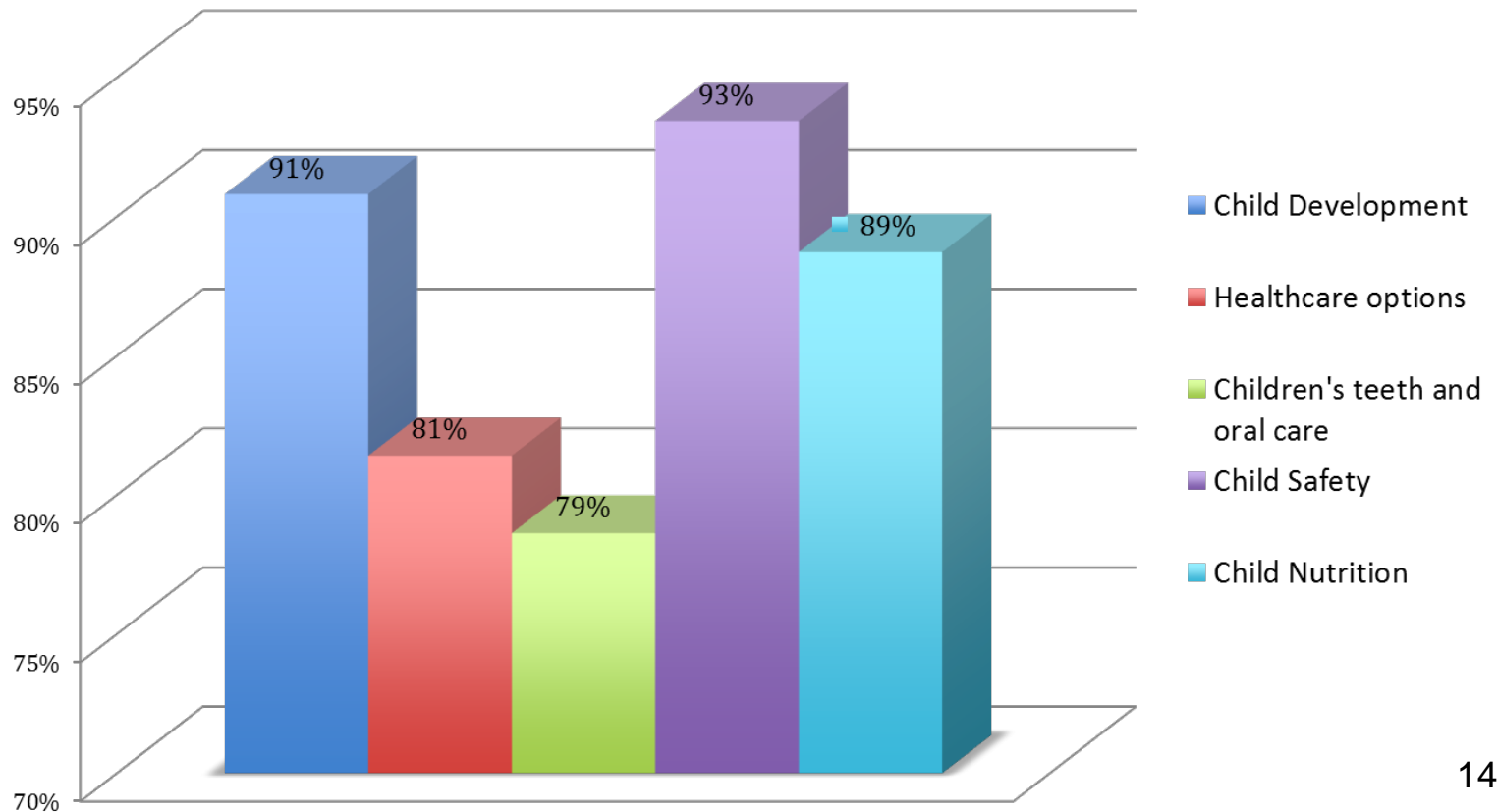
A High Percentage of Parents Used the *Kit*
