Family Functioning: Providing parents, families and communities with relevant, timely and culturally appropriate information, education, services and support.

#	Measurable Program Goals
1	Increase the total number of children with parents reading to them daily.
2	Increased involvement of parents in early care and education programs.
3	Increase the total number of parents receiving psycho-social screenings for depression, substance abuse, and other risk factors, and are referred for treatment for depression and other family risk factors.
4	Decrease the total number of teen pregnancies .
5	Increase the total number of families participating in a home visitation program.
6	Increase the total number of programs offering respite care .

Child Health: Promoting optimal health through identification, treatment and elimination of the risks that threaten children’s health and lead to developmental delays and disabilities in young children.

#	Measurable Program Goals
1	Increase the total number of families with a medical home .
2	Increase the total number of trainings for 0 to 5 service providers on smoking cessation and related smoking illnesses.
3	Increase the total number of women receiving prenatal care services before the third month of pregnancy.
4	Increase the total number of children who are screened, assessed, and/or referred for vision impairments, hearing impairments, dental decay and developmental delays according to specificity of the appropriate agency such as the American Academy of Pediatrics.
5	Increase the total number of children living in healthy and safe environments .
6	Increase the total number of children 0 to 5 with access to specialized health services as needed (mental health, etc.).
7	Increase the total number of children with health insurance .
8	Increase the total number of children 0 to 5 who receive regular well-child visits according to the schedule recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics.
9	Increase the total number of children receiving age-appropriate nutrition , meals, and snacks daily.
10	Increase the total number of children who are exclusively breast fed during the first 6 months of life.
11	Increase the total number of children receiving appropriate and timely oral health visits according to American Dental Association.
12	Increase the total number of children receiving complete immunizations at the appropriate time according to the American Academy of Pediatrics.

Child Development: Increasing the quality of and access to early learning and education for young children.

#	Measurable Program Goals
1	Increase the total number of children entering kindergarten ready for school (across five developmental domains—fine motor, gross motor, social/emotional, language, and cognitive).
2	Increase the total number of children receiving supports during transition to/from new environments.
3	Increase the total number of early care and education settings that are accredited and/or receive a “passing score” using a valid and reliable quality assessment tool.
4	Increase the total number of 0 to 5 programs with a “passing score” on a quality rating system .
5	Increase the total number of licensed, comprehensive, full-day, quality 0 to 5 programs .
6	Increase the total number of licensed, comprehensive, full-day quality infant/toddler programs .
7	Increase the total number of licensed, comprehensive, full-day quality preschool programs .
8	Increase the total number of high quality 0 to 5 services .
9	Increase the total number of 0 to 5 service providers receiving mental health and other employee assistance services as needed.
10	Increase the total number of license-exempt 0 to 5 service providers with child development training .
11	Increase the total number of infant/toddler specialists in the early care and education and mental health workforce.
12	Increase the total number of programs and services targeting special populations (foster care, homeless shelters, poverty, rural/urban areas).

Systems of Care: Implementing integrated, comprehensive, inclusive and culturally and linguistically appropriate services to achieve improvements in one or more of the other focus areas.

#	Measurable Program Goals
1	Increase the total number of education and training programs that increase the number and skills of service providers to deliver family-centered, and culturally and linguistically sensitive and responsive services.
2	Increase the wage and/or incentives for 0 to 5 service providers.
3	Increase the total number of trainings for 0 to 5 service providers responsive to the needs of the children in their programs such as inclusive practices and English learners.
4	Increase the retention rates of early childhood development and health professionals.
5	Increase the total number of professionals working in early childhood care and education settings with a degree .
6	Increase the total number of integrated services where programs have common intake strategies, assessment tools, and multi-disciplinary focus.
7	Increase the total number of programs with expanded service hours or with flexible schedules.
